



2026 New Mexico Summer Reading Program Site Partnership Information

By enrolling as a New Mexico Summer Reading Program Site Partner, you are expressing interest in hosting the program at your district, school, or community site for Summer 2026. Site partners may enroll now; however, final commitments to host should be confirmed by **December 2, 2025**.

The 2026 New Mexico Summer Reading Program is:

- The New Mexico Summer Reading Program is a free, daily four-hour literacy program designed to prevent summer learning loss and build reading confidence. Participating students receive small-group, targeted literacy tutoring delivered by trained tutors at your site.
- Program Duration: Four (4) weeks in June 2026
Program Window: June 1 – June 30, 2026
Optional Extension: Additional weeks in July 2026 may be available

As a 2026 New Mexico Summer Reading Program Site Partner, you will:

- Host a program at your school or facility for four hours per day, for four weeks within the June program window.
- Designate a Site Coordinator to oversee the program and tutor team in collaboration with NMPED. Recommended candidates include administrators, instructional coaches, or teachers.
- Collaborate with NMPED to identify and select Literacy Instructor candidates from your organization or school community.
- To the fullest extent possible, provide:
 - Meals and transportation for participating students
 - Extended-day or enrichment programming
 - Access to 1:1 technology and internet during program hours
- Recruit and prioritize students who are below or far below grade level in reading, ensuring they and their families have access to this targeted resource.



As your partners, NMPED will:

- Coordinate compensation for all Site Coordinators and Literacy Instructors.
- Provide comprehensive support, including curriculum, training materials, and ongoing technical assistance.
- Manage all student and family registration through the Literacy.nm.gov website beginning Winter 2025.
- Consult with site partners regarding the provision of meals and transportation.
