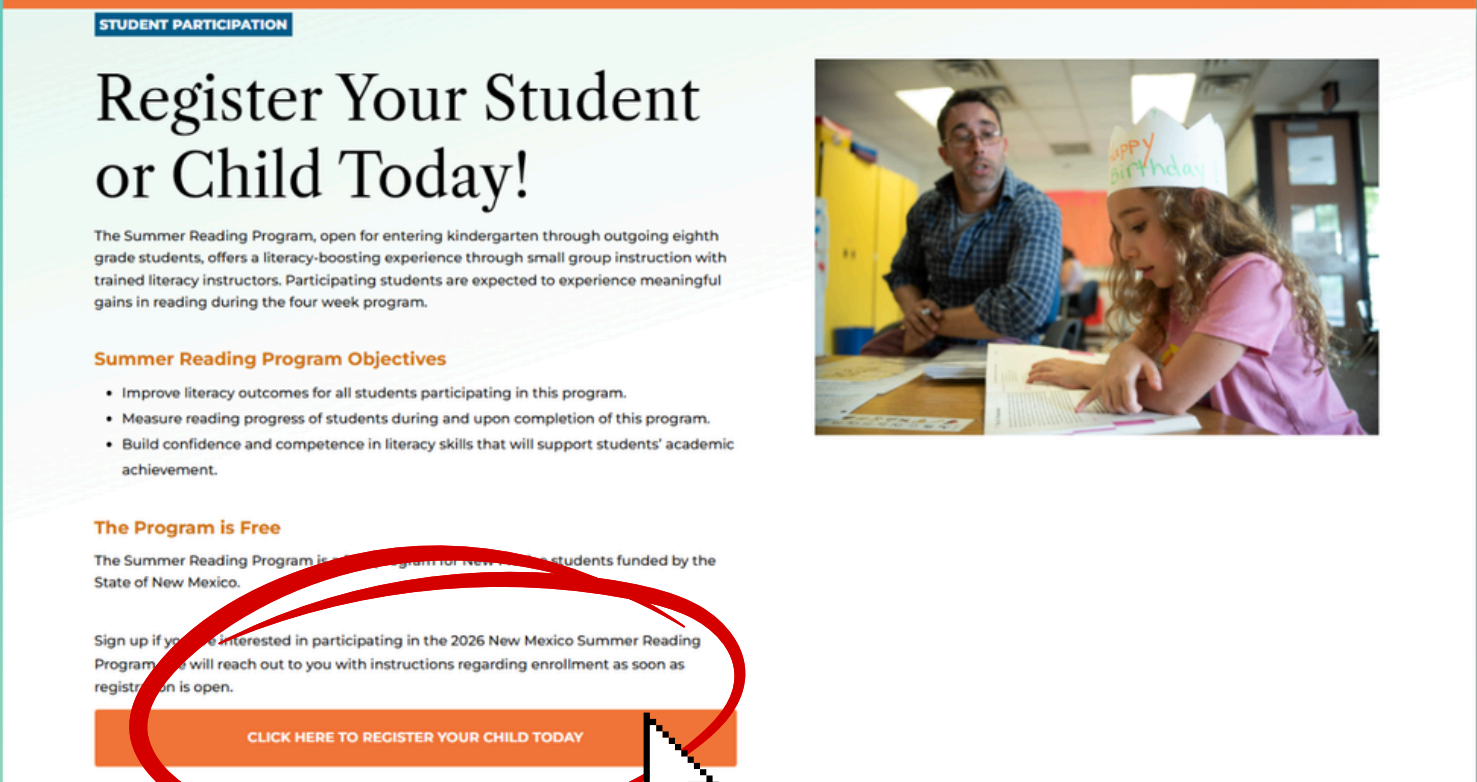

Parent Registration Guide

Step 1: Go to the Registration Website

Visit **literacy.nm.gov** and click on **Register Child**. This will take you to the login screen where you will begin the registration process.

Summer Reading Program Objectives

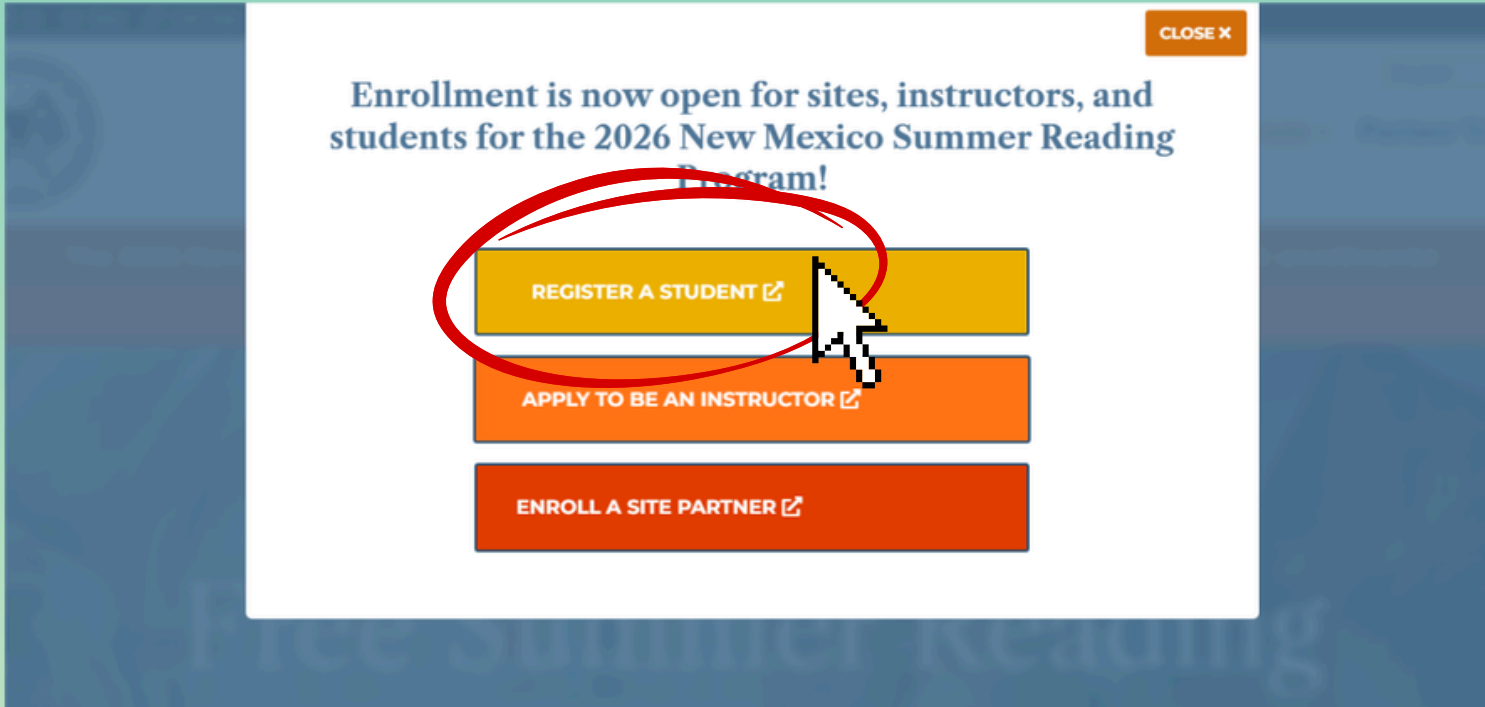
- Improve literacy outcomes for all students participating in this program.

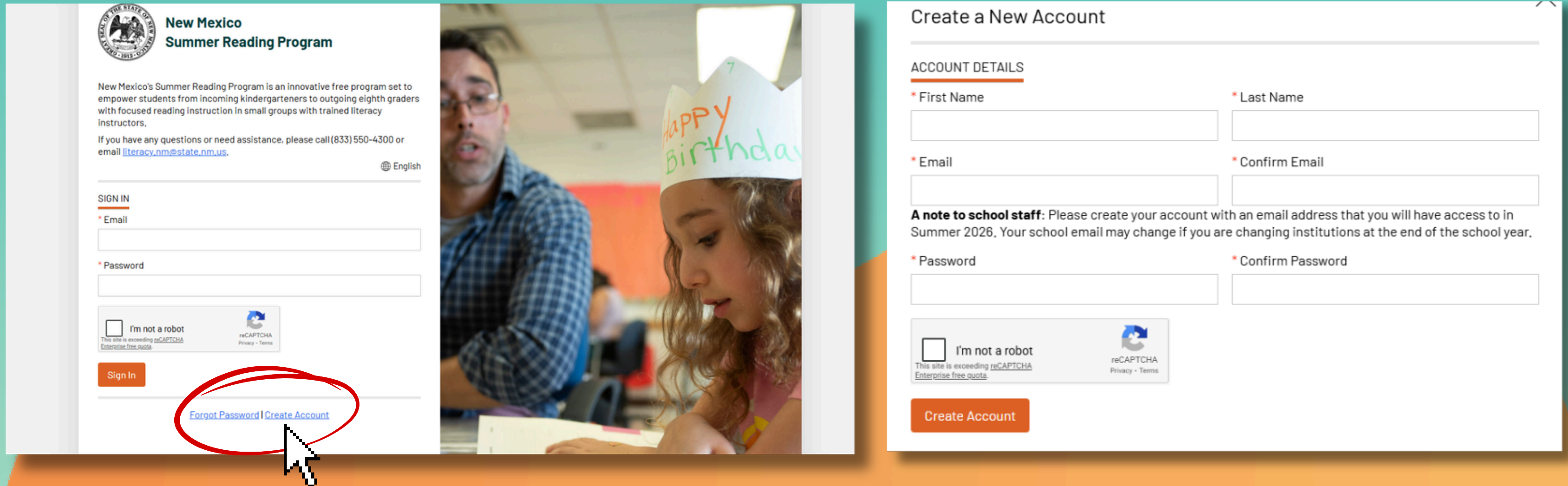

Step 2: Create an Account or Log In

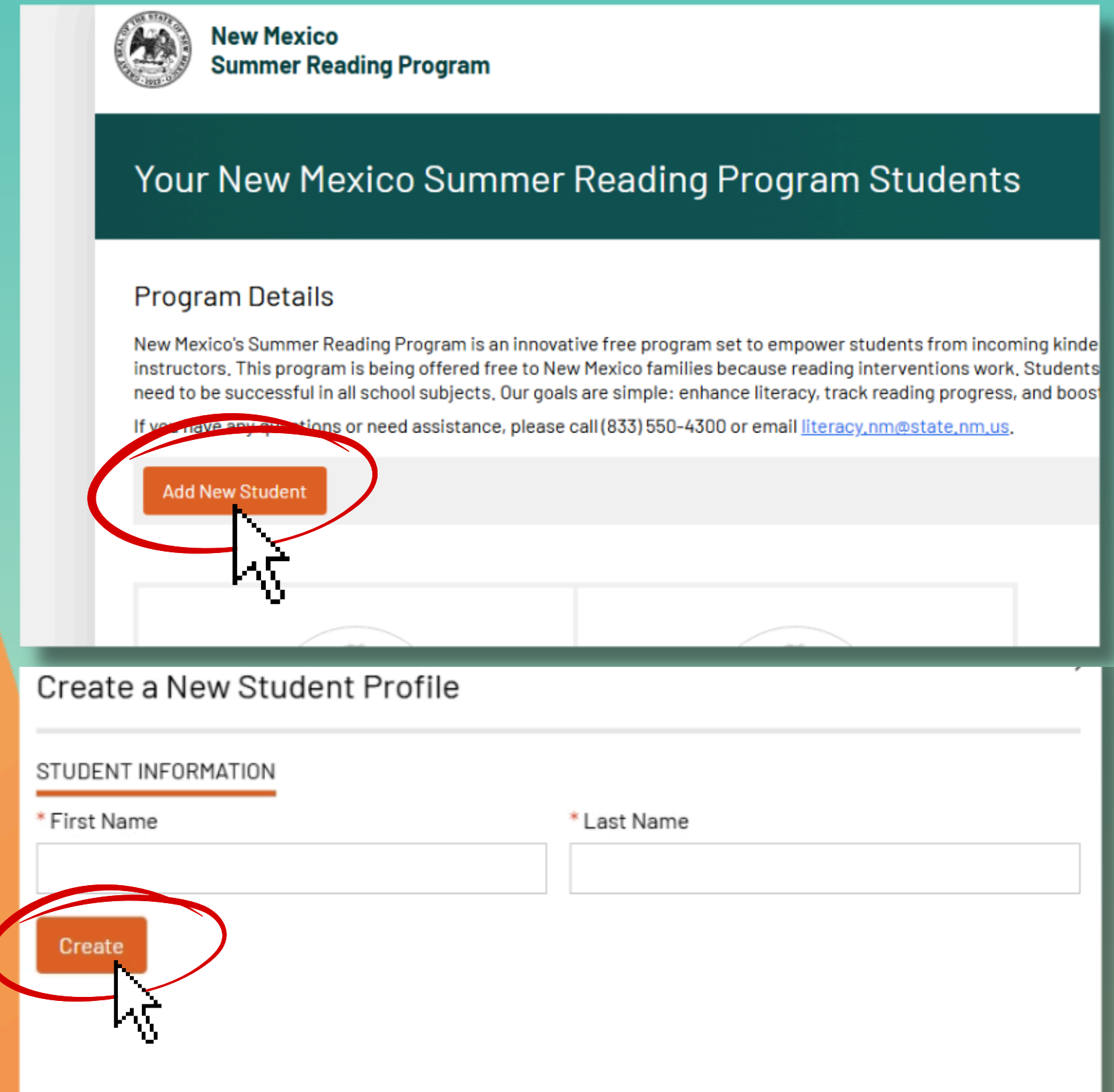

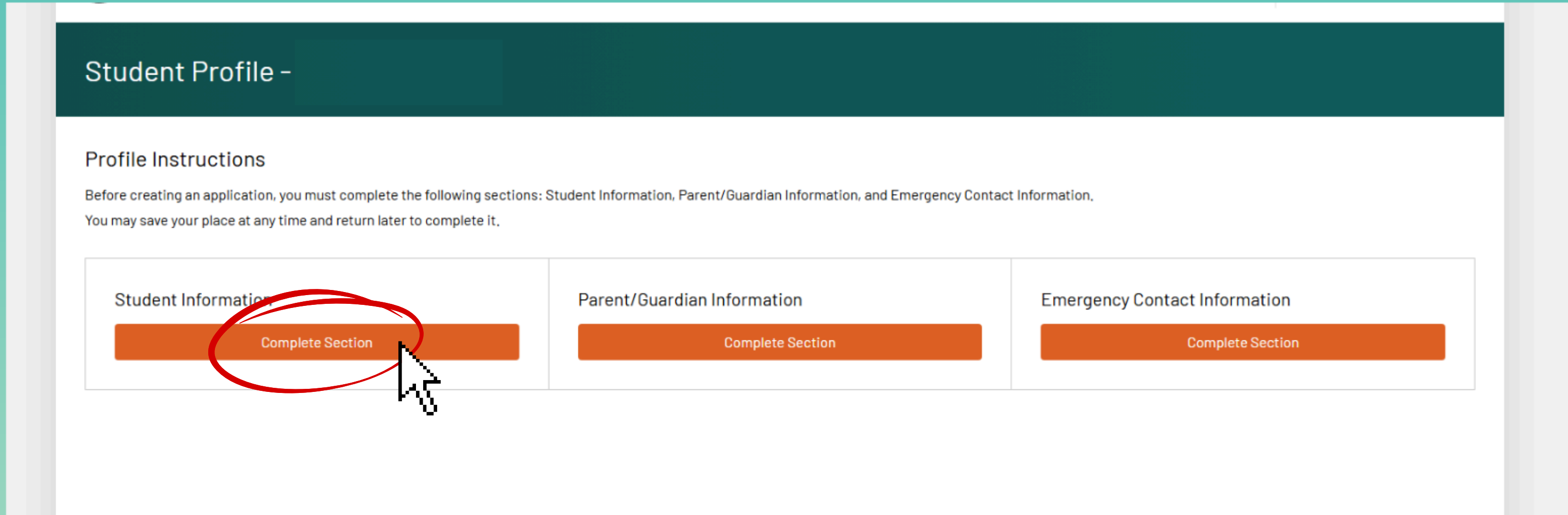
Step 3: Add a New Student

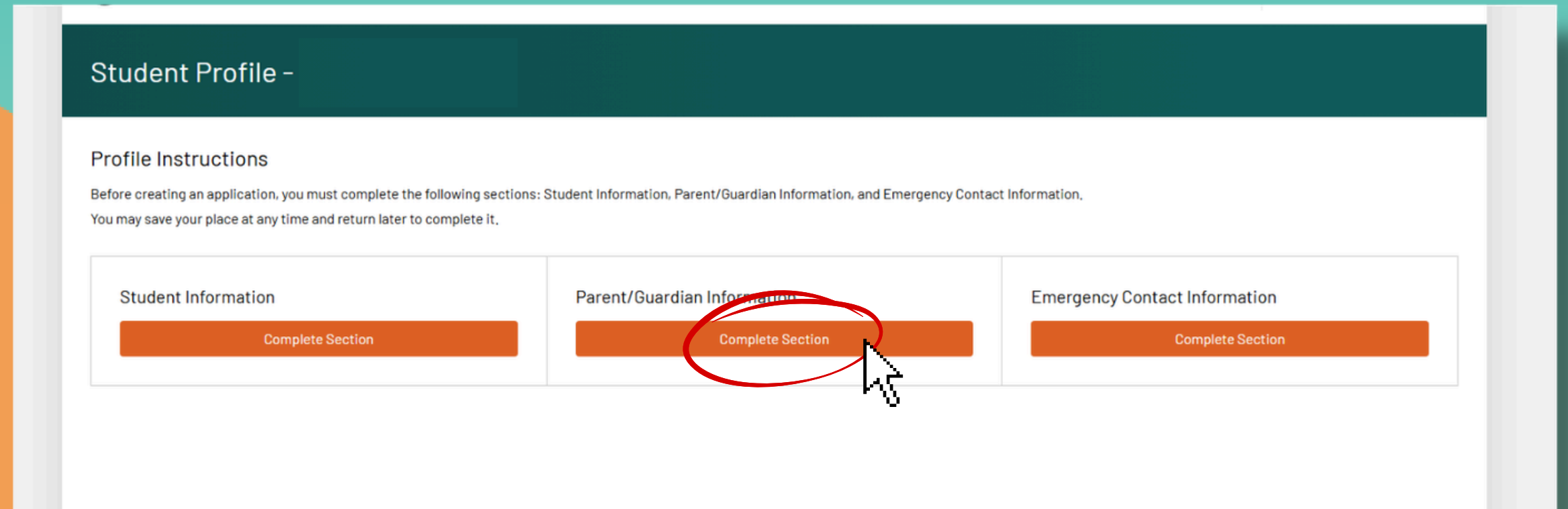

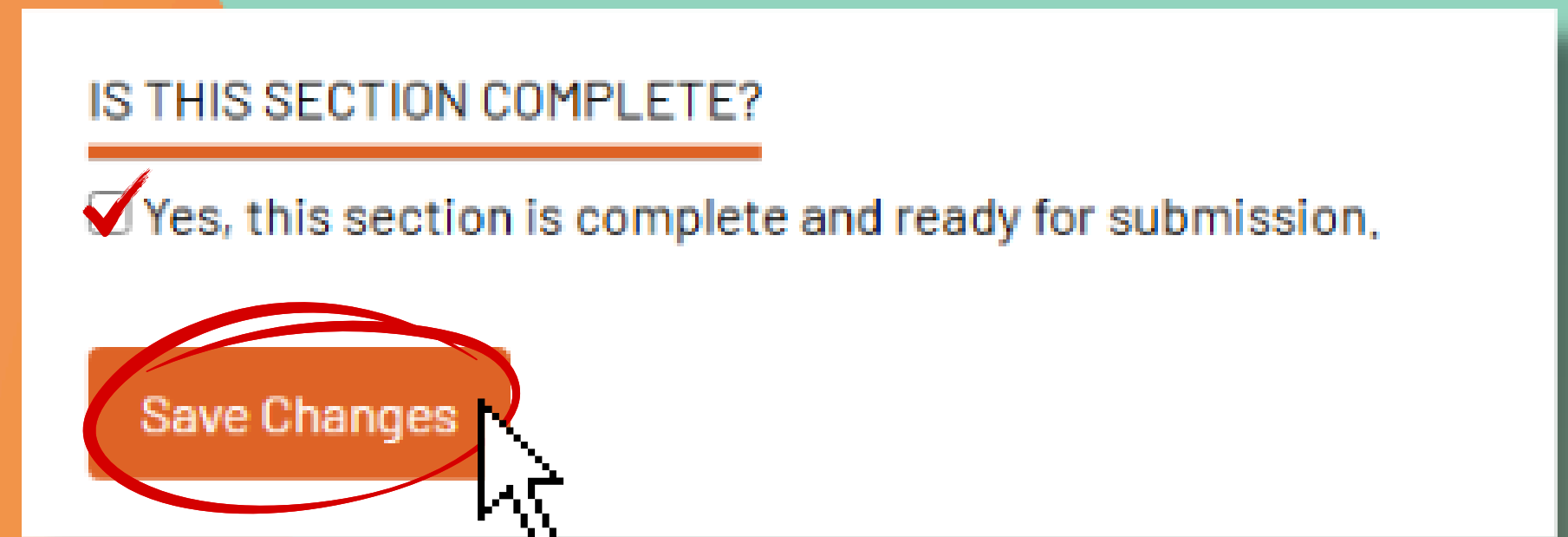

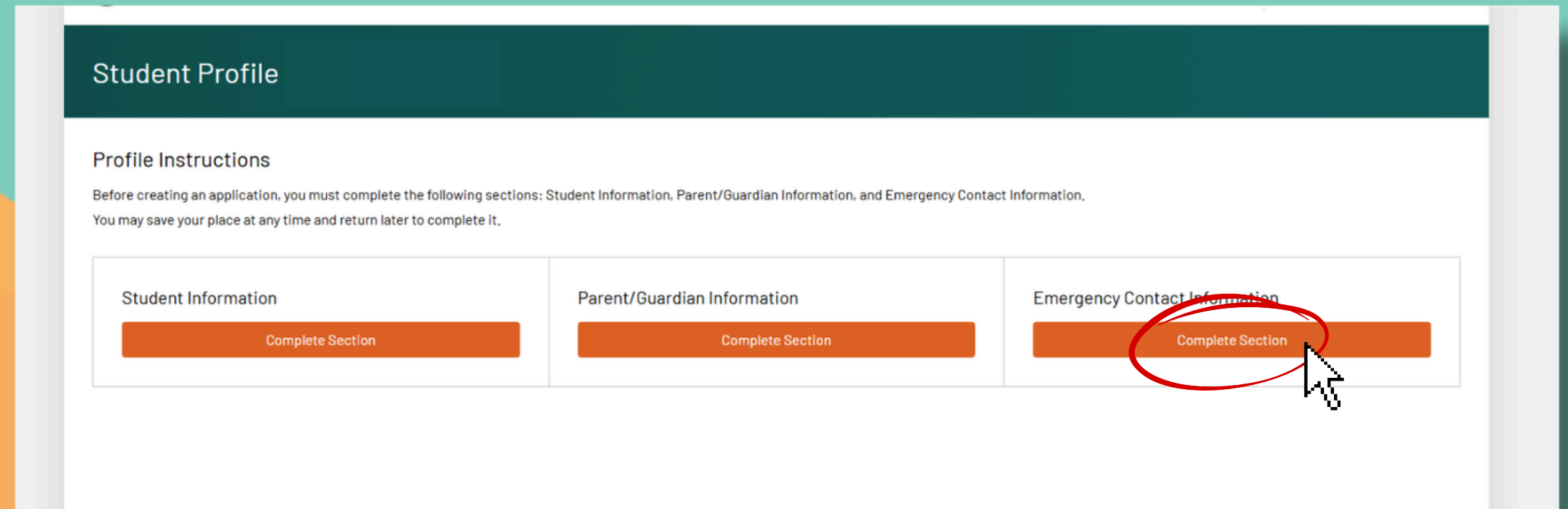

After completing the section, check the box that says **Yes, this section is complete**, then click **Save Changes**. Once all three sections are complete, you will be able to start a new application.

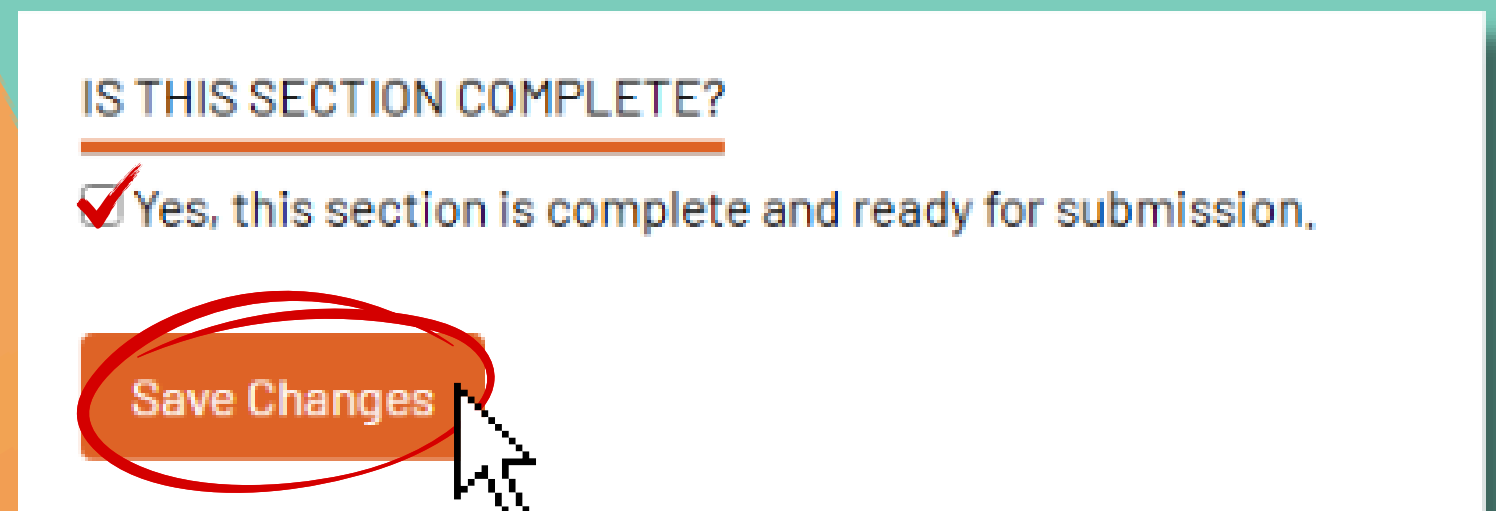

Step 8: Select Region Preferences

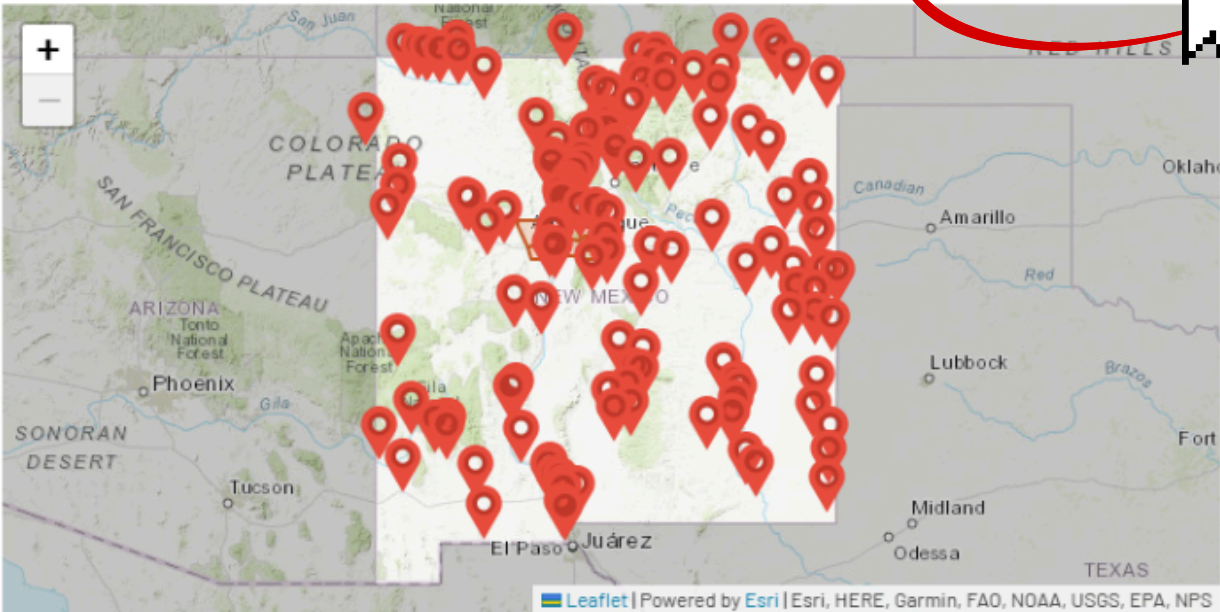

Timeline:

After submitting your application, you should receive an email confirming your application was received. Please check your inbox and spam folder if needed. You will also see a timeline appear in your account that allows you to track the status of your application. You may log in at any time to check your status. If you don't receive the email, log in again to resend it.

Step 10: Placement Notification Email



After your student application is accepted by a program location, you will receive an email notifying you that action is required. This email will ask you to Accept Placement, Decline Placement, or Withdraw Application.

Important: You must take action within 7 days of receiving the email. If no action is taken within this timeframe, the placement will expire and your child's assigned spot may no longer be available.

Step 11: Select Your Placement Action

Accept Placement:

Selecting this option confirms your child's enrollment at the assigned site and reserves their spot in the program.

Decline Placement:

Select this option if you would prefer a different site location. Please note that placement at another site is not guaranteed and will depend on availability.

Withdraw Application:

Select this option if you no longer want your child to participate in the 2026 New Mexico Summer Reading Program. This will remove your child from the application process.

Be sure to review your selection carefully before submitting, as this will update your student's application
